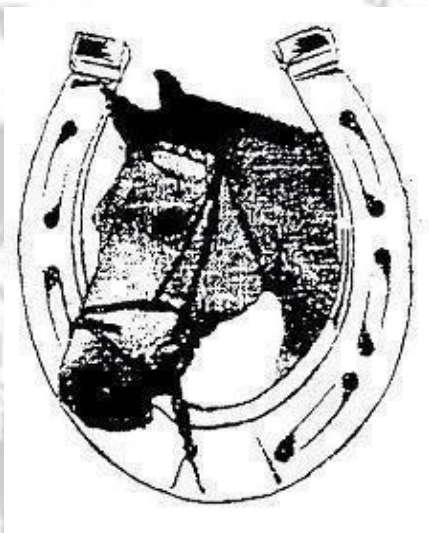

STARS Champion of Champions

Our Riding Club is affiliated to STARS - Showing Teams and Rising Stars.

How to qualify:

- You have to be a South Derbyshire Saddle Club Member in 2026 to qualify.
- Qualification will be taken from points accrued over the season which give rise to our Champion, Reserve or 2nd Reserve for each of the qualifying classes. Should the Champion be unable to attend the STARS finals then we can offer the place to the Reserve, followed by the 2nd Reserve.
- South Derbyshire Saddle Club will send the results after the final club show in September then STARS will post a golden ticket to the qualifying competitors.
- An exhibitor may compete in more than one section at the Championships providing that they meet the criteria above for each section.
- No change of combination of horse/pony rider/handler is permitted from that which qualified through South Derbyshire Saddle Club. Should any horse/pony be sold before this competition takes place the qualification will be offered to the next eligible exhibit (Res, /2nd Res).
- No horse/pony can compete at STARS if they have qualified for HOYS in the current year.
- You have to attend at least 2 of South Derbyshire Saddle Club “Club” shows.
- Classes marked with a star are qualifiers for STARS ★.
- **Aintree are now running on a 6-month rule for vaccination so please make sure your horse is up to date if you are planning to compete this year. ★★**

The STARS final will be held at Aintree, Liverpool.

How to qualify:

First, second and third placed horses/ponies not already qualified in eligible classes will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at Olney Grounds Equestrian Centre. If a horse/pony has already qualified, cards may be handed down to 6th place at judge's discretion.

Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Championship Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the Concours d'Elegance Society within 21 days of the qualifying show. No horse registration is required.

SHOWING RING NOT BEFORE 9.45am

- ★ 1. Tack and Turnout - Open to all (STARS Class 19)
2. Beginners Showing – WALK & TROT only. May have an assistant in the ring. This class is designed for genuine beginners only & riders who may have a disability who can only walk & trot & may need assistance in the ring. **This showing combination cannot go in any other ridden showing class EXCEPT Tack and Turnout**
3. Novice & Nervous Showing – open to novice riders and/or horses. Will be walk & trot only in the go round, optional canter in the individual show piece. **This showing combination cannot go in any other ridden showing class EXCEPT Tack and Turnout**
- ★ 4. Lead Rein Showing - snaffle bridle only Lead Rein attached to noseband (STARS L/R Plaited 4 - 9 years not exc 128cm - Class 20)
- ★ 5. 11 years & under Showing - snaffle bridles only. Canter optional in show piece (STARS Plaited First Ridden Not exc 128cm - Class 21)
(Classes 4 and 5 may be amalgamated if insufficient entries)
- ★ 6. Ridden Showing (not exc 14.2hh) to include Show ponies, part breds, riding pony - (STARS Plaited pony Class 24)
- ★ 7. Ridden Plaited (exc 14.2hh) to include TB (inc ex Racehorses, Arabs etc) - (STARS Plaited Horse Class 25)
8. Concours d’Elegance - any height to be ridden astride or side saddle

WORKING HUNTER - NOT BEFORE 10.00am

Horses/ponies can only enter 2 working hunter classes

Working Hunter classes will consist of 2 phases - jumping and showing. The jumping course will consist of at least 5 fences, all of a hunting type, built from rustic material and as substantial as possible. Penalties are as follows:

A complete turnaround or resistance is judged as a refusal. No schooling whips. No combination of horse and rider may enter more than two classes. A person may enter each class only once.

- ★ 26. Working Hunter - Lead Rein. Jumps up to 30cm - short course - (STARS L/R WHP not exc 128cm not to have attained their 10th birthday jumps up to 30cm Class 6)
- ★ 27. Working Hunter - 11 years & under. Jumps up to 45cm - short course (STARS Cradle Stakes WHP not exc 128cm not to have attained their 11th birthday jumps up to 45cm Class 7)
- 28. Working Hunter - Beginners - any height. Jumps up to 45cm
- ★ 29. Working Hunter – M & M small breeds not exc. 133cms. Jumps up to 55cms (STARS M&M Small Breed Jumps up to 70cm max Class 4)
- 30. Working Hunter - any height. Jumps up to 55cm
- ★ 31. Working Hunter - any height. Jumps up to 65cm - (STARS Open 70cm WHP 133cm and under (plaited or hogged) Class 1)
- ★ 32. Working Hunter – M & M large breeds exc. 133cms. Jumps up to 75cms (STARS M&M large breeds exc. 133cm jumps up to 85cm Class 5)
- ★ 33. Working Hunter - any height. Jumps up to 75cm - (STARS WHP Exc 133cm but not exc 153cm (plaited or hogged) jumps up to 80cm: Class 2, STARS WH Exc. 153cm Class 3 - jumps up to 95cm)

SHOW JUMPING CLASSES - Horses/ponies can only enter 2 show jumping classes.

A complete turnaround is judged as a refusal. Resistance is judged as a refusal and where resistance is for more than 1 minute the competitor will be eliminated. Competitors who start before the starting bell/whistle has been sounded will be eliminated. Course error will also result in elimination.

SHOW JUMPING SMALL RING (MINIMUS) NOT BEFORE 12.30pm

39. Show Jumping - Tiny Tots Lead Rein (5 years & under) - jumps up to 20cm
40. Show Jumping Nervous and Novice - jumps up to 30cm - Open to all. Can be assisted in the ring (Lead Rein competitors can enter this class off lead rein)
41. Show Jumping - Lead Rein (6 - 9 years) - jumps up to 30cm
42. Show Jumping - 11 years & under - jumps up to 45cm

Minimus will be open throughout the day as announced

SHOW JUMPING - MAIN RING NOT BEFORE 12.00 noon

43. Show Jumping - Beginners - any height - jumps up to 45cm (A combination may only enter this class if they have not won or been runner up in a previous season).
44. Show Jumping - any height - jumps up to 55cm
45. Show Jumping - any height - jumps up to 65cm
46. Show Jumping - any height - jumps up to 75cm
47. Show Jumping - any height - jumps up to 85cm



GAMES SECTION - RULES

Each pony may be ridden only once in each age group

- a. Each rider may enter no more than one pony in each game
- b. Any combinations of horse and rider, which have qualified to do so, may ride in a final ride off
- c. Ponies in Lead Rein games must not exceed 13.2hh
- d. Riders of Lead Rein age who compete competitively off Lead Rein in other classes can compete in Lead Rein games and will be awarded the appropriate rosette BUT will not be awarded points in this class. If they wish to compete competitively, they must enter the Step Up 6 – 9 years off Lead rein games.
- e. The leader in Lead Rein games must be 14 years & over
- f. No spurs or whips will be allowed in the games
- g. Walk or trot only in 5 years & under
- h. All general rules will apply
- i. The wearing of body protectors is recommended

Handlers must be of smart appearance at all times in the ring. (See general rules)

In Hand Championship - Open to anyone placed 1st or 2nd in any of the In-Hand Classes 57 – 68

Hobby Horse Classes - These classes will be held in the relevant classes in their designated rings at the beginning of each set of classes

69. Hobby Horse Handy Pony – open to all – from 11.00am
70. Hobby Horse Showjumping – open to all. – 12.00 noon
71. Hobby Horse Games – open to all. – 2.00pm

Points will be awarded & go towards End of Season trophies to be awarded to the 4 highest placed overall Hobby Horse competitors of the season. PLEASE NOTE – these points will not count to overall age championships



POINTS COMPETITION SECTION

1. All competitive club classes and all gymkhana games points shall count towards the members' points' competition.
2. Points shall be awarded as follows:

3. No points shall accrue until after membership fees for the current year have been paid.
4. Points are awarded for per combination of horse/pony and rider/handler.
5. A combination of horse/pony and rider/handler must enter a class at least 3 times to qualify for an end of season trophy.
6. The members gaining the most points throughout the year in a particular group and discipline shall be deemed the overall winner for that group and discipline. However, you can only be eligible for an overall winner's trophy if there has been at least two club members competing in the same class for a minimum of three shows.
7. We have **TWO OVERALL SUPREME CHAMPIONS** at the end of the season. We have a **SUPREME CHAMPION** for our mini competitors so our competitors 11 years & under competing in their appropriate classes and a **SUPREME CHAMPION** for our competitors 12 years & over. For our Supreme Champions we will be taking the scores from your eight highest placed classes at the end of the season. We feel this will be fairer to all competitors.



Dog Show Classes

This is a Fun Dog Show. All dogs Must be on a lead and under control at all times. Any child showing a dog MUST be supervised at ALL times. Please bring your own poo bags and clean up after your dog.

Dog Show entries are by tokens only. They can be pre-purchased for £2.50 each or 5 for £10.00 & used at any show. Rosettes to 6th place.

GENERAL RULES

- 1 **All persons attending events organised by South Derbyshire Saddle Club do so entirely at their own risk. Its management committee and persons acting on their behalf will not accept responsibility for any loss, damage, accident or injury to any persons, animals or property however caused.**
- 2 **All rider age is as of 1st January in the year they are competing.**
- 3 **All competitors must have adequate third-party insurance.**
- 4 If you have a complaint, please make it in writing and hand it in on the day of the show together with a £20.00 deposit which will be forfeited if is not upheld by the committee.
- 5 **We have ZERO tolerance of any type of abuse/threatening behaviour/harassment in person or on any social networking sites, towards judges, club officials, competitors or spectators.** Anyone found to be doing this will be asked to leave the ground immediately and your membership will be revoked.
- 6 The judge's decision is **FINAL**.
- 7 In the interest of safety competitors may exercise/lunge their horse/pony in the area provided. **They must not exercise in the car park or horsebox area or in the spectator areas/walk ways.** Except when competing in the ring or working in the designated practice area animals **must proceed at a walk**.
- 8 Correct riding attire & suitable footwear must be worn at all times while mounted & showing In Hand on the show ground.
- 9 All riders under 18 must wear a fastened strapped current British Standard/PAS approved riding hat. Those over 18 wishing to wear a Beagler/Top Hat/Bowler may do so their own risk but must sign a disclaimer. However, we do strongly advise & recommend that all persons wear a fastened strapped British Standard Riding Hat. Correct footwear must be worn when mounted - no trainers when mounted!
- 10 No horse/pony under 4 years old shall be allowed in any ridden class.
- 11 Stallions are welcome but must be bitted from yearling onwards.
- 12 Any horse or pony may have more than one rider provided the same combination does not compete in the same class.
- 13 Lead Rein classes - **Children to be aged 9 years & under. Ponies not exc. 13.2hh.**
- 14 Lead Rein ponies must be in a snaffle bridle with the Lead Rein attached to the noseband Lead Rein age competitors wanting to ride off the Lead Rein must decide if they wish to accrue points in either Lead Rein Classes or Non-Lead Rein classes and must declare their intent. They can enter either classes and the appropriate rosette will be given but they can only accrue one set of points, either on or off Lead Rein, towards the end of season trophies.



- 15 The leader in all Lead Rein classes including Variety Classes must be over 14 years.
- 16 No **junior** competitor may wear spurs at any time on the show ground.
- 17 The height/weight of a competitor must be appropriate for the horse/pony they are riding.
- 18 Where the height of a horse/pony is in dispute a height certificate may be requested or the animal measured.
- 19 Where the age of a horse/pony is in dispute proof of age maybe required.
- 20 In line with current DEFRA guidelines all horses/ponies must have a current passport available for inspection at any time.
- 21 We strongly advise the wearing of body protectors.
- 22 All earrings and body studs should be removed before competing.
- 23 Lamé, unwell or unfit horses will be asked to retire from the class.
- 24 A horse/pony known to kick must wear a red ribbon at the top of their tail.
- 25 It is the competitor's responsibility to get to their appropriate ring on time.
- 26 The Club and its committee cannot be held responsible for classes clashing.
- 27 Maximum length of whips must not exceed 30" except in dressage.
- 28 Excessive use of the whip or ill treatment will not be tolerated and could result in the person being asked to leave the ground and their membership being revoked.
- 29 Bit less entries are welcome in any class APART FROM DRESSAGE – see BD rules
- 30 Except where those rules are inconsistent with the rules made by the SDSC, the rules of the B.H.S. and B.S.J.A. shall apply.
- 31 **Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.**
- 32 **Owners of dogs fouling on the field must clear up after them and take the waste home with them - we have no facilities to dispose of dog waste!**
- 33 Anyone parking a vehicle inappropriately will be asked to move it.
- 34 On entering & leaving the show ground the Main Gate **MUST** be closed behind you.
- 35 Membership is discretionary. The club can refuse to allow a person membership without explanation.
- 36 Any perpetual trophies presented annually must be returned to the club by the last club show.
- 37 The AGM will be held during February/March.
- 38 The committee's decision is **FINAL**.

NON-COMPLIANCE WITH ANY CLUB RULE MAY RESULT IN FURTHER ACTION BEING TAKEN
